

PFAS Statement

Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are perceived as a global environmental concern and are subject to increasing legal, health, and environmental pressures.

Holík International does not intentionally use materials that would contain PFAS substances over limited values given by the US regulations on PFAS.

Out of the complete material composition of our NFPA 1971 compliant models Brenna and Tarren, only 5.7% of materials contain a small amount of PFAS—these materials are compliant with Öko-Tex 100 certification, meaning that the value is not reaching over 100ppm.

The reason Holík use these materials is to comply with the high demands of NFPA 1971 norm and to protect the user with its hydrophobic and oleophobic properties.

Holík International with its motto “Your Safety Comes First” is engaged in the development of PFAS-free materials, in order to be able to substitute the affected materials with completely PFAS-free materials without the minimal sacrifice of the protective properties of the user.
